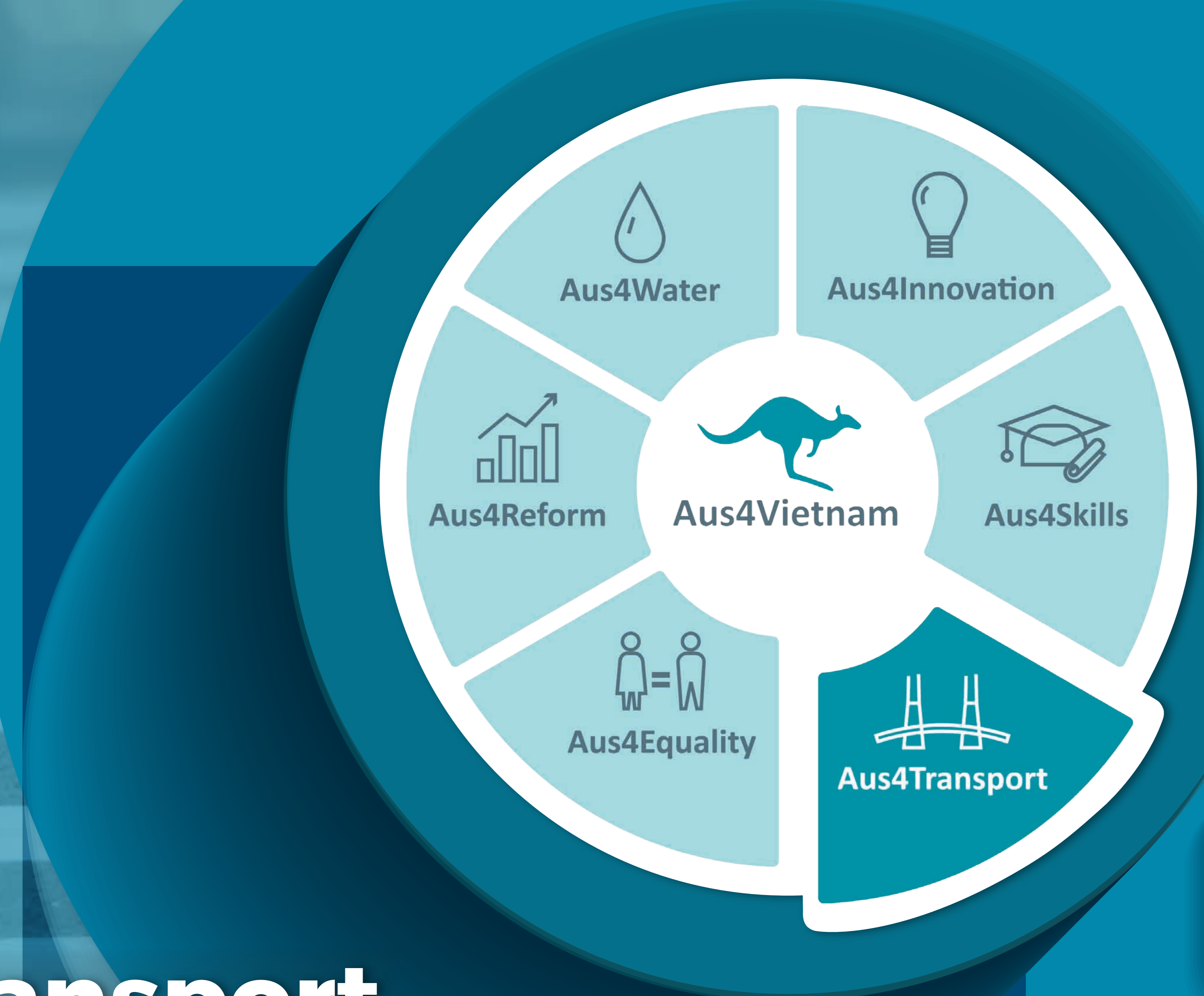

It will also support local officials and civil society to practically implement these new standards in public transport projects across Vietnam.
